

Prof. Dr. Tea Petelava

Prof. Dr. Tea Petelava is a Lingvist for German language. Her focus is on language and cultural education, German as a professional and technical language, discourse and applied linguistics. In 2011, Prof. Dr. Petelava received her doctorate at the TSU on the topic: "Intralinguistic and extralinguistic aspects of the interpretation of a narrative text". She is the author of over 20 scientific publications. Prof. Dr. Petelava continuously participates in training courses and conferences locally, but also in Europe.

Prof. Tea Petelava is the organizer and co-organizer of several international conferences and editor of the contributions to the international conferences.

Ms. Prof. Dr. Tea Petelava has received numerous scientific funding from the DAAD, Goethe Institutes, ÖAD and the Federal Ministry of Education.

Since 2001, Prof. Dr. Tea Petelava works at the Iv.Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University. Since 2007 she has been working in the Humanities Faculty at the University of Georgia. Since 2017 she has been leading international programs as part of the European Language Institute. Since 2020 she has been head of the international department for technical and higher education and is also involved as a multiplier for teacher training for universities. Since 2021, Prof. Tea Petelava has been a subject matter expert and member of the Higher Education Council Commission for the Development of the Common National Linguistic Framework of Reference for Higher Education at the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement of Georgia.
